## Windmill Museum

Bircham mill has been restored to its former glory. Visitors are able to explore the five floors and peruse the information on each level.

Adults can listen to the millers stories while children can follow the mouse trail.



## Tea Rooms & Gift Shop

The Tea Room serves a selection of home made cakes, scones and light lunches, a full range of English and Italian coffees, teas and of course our famous clotted cream teas. Inside the tea rooms is the gift shop.



## Bakery

The wonderful smell of freshly baked bread welcomes visitors to the original bakery which adjoins the mill. Visitors can buy flour, fresh bread, rolls, scones and cakes.

## Make & Bake bread making experience

Suitable for anyone aged 2 -102, come and have a go at making bread. Choose a simple start from the dough stage for £3.10, or make a loaf from scratch for £5.20, after which you can take home the recipe (available on request). Everyone gets to take their bread home for tea too. Full instructions and support given, but activities are not staff supervised.

## Film Room

Visitors can select a film, then sit back and relax. Topics include local history, Bircham Mill virtual tour and the restoration of Bircham Mill.

## Fun for Children
