Windmill Museum

Bircham Mill has been restored to its former glory. Visitors are able to explore the five floors and peruse the information on each level and listen to the miller while children can follow the mouse trail.

When possible on windy days the sails turn the milling machinery inside.

Tea Rooms & Gallery

The Tea Room serves a selection of home made cakes, scones and light lunches, a full range of English and Italian coffees, teas and of course our famous Clotted Cream Teas. Inside the Tea Rooms is the Art Gallery - different artist each month, and the Gift Shop.



Bakery & Baking Shop

The wonderful smell of freshly baked bread welcomes visitors to the original bakery which adjoins the mill. (No bread Saturdays). Extending into the mill is the baking shop, selling flour, fresh bread, rolls, scones and cakes, baking items, books, gifts and much more. 'Children's Baking Corner', bake some bread to take home for tea, £2 per child.



Sheep Milking

Every day at 2pm our milk sheep come into their mini parlour for milking. Visitors can view the milking for free and buy the cheese that we make on site.



Cycle Hire & Walks

Family cycle hire centre providing cycles for all the family. Routes for one hour, two hours or all day. Trailer bikes, children's trailers and child seats.

A separate leaflet with prices is available, or phone the Mill for details.

Walk routes available from the Mill. Hire bikes for 2 or more hours or spend over £25 on cycle hire and receive 20% off windmill entrance.
